1. Current view of the project since our last meeting.

Catalan team: prepared the ppt presentations of the sports and races to be done. They also trained in extra PE lessons for the different athletic races which had to be done.

Italian and Turkish team prepared and trained in their PE lessons, the Italian team didn't do any ppt presentations. Both countries who had prepared the presentations (Turkey & Catalonia) weren't able to present as the sports prepared weren't practised in the mini-Olympics.

English team didn't train nor prepare anything which was stated in the programme.

All the teachers of the visiting countries (Catalonia, Italy and Turkey) wish to point out that none of the athletic competitions were organised as stated in the previous teachers workshops which took place in Terrassa and Pescara.

As we see it, it seems there's been a lack of communication between the organiser of the English team and the participating teachers in the above mentioned workshops.

## 2. Plans for the following months.

Prior to our trip to Turkey, each school will create any kind of research, no matter what form it is, but will keep to the topic of the project. Anything related to sports, brotherhood, war, peace... The production can be of any sort: poem, play, presentation, narrative, whatever it feels will inspire the students more. A facebook page can be created for the students to cooperate in their works, so as to try to work cooperatively.

A survey will be passed to the students to evaluate their stay as well as to the families who have hosted the students, either on this trip or in the two previous ones. The survey will be used as evaluation coming from the students and from the families. The questionnaire will be sent in a google form to facilitate the results.

## 3. Trip to Turkey.

The dates will be the following: from 12th to 19th February 2015. The idea is to arrive on the 12th and start the activities on the 13th. The activities will finish on the 18th and we'll be leaving on the 19th.

Before the trip, we will have had to do all the creative work mentioned before and the students will present their work in Turkey.

## 4. Dissemination and evaluation.

At the teachers' workshop in Turkey we will bring some of the questions about the values of olympism and about what we have learned from the project and European values. We will write a questionnaire again to be answered by students and used as evaluation.

To let everybody know what we have done, through the two-year project, a web page, [www.tecnos.cat/international](http://www.tecnos.cat/international), was created in 2014 by the Catalan school and all the materials done have been uploaded there, as well as the summaries of the teachers workshop.

To finish with the activities, we will produce an e-book, the 4 different schools can upload what they value most or consider the most representative tasks which have been done. The e-book can be printed if the schools want to.

The e-book will consist on four different parts, one per each school.

It is the duty of each school to send their works to the coordinating school to be able to fill in the web page to update all the information.

We talk about the possibility of applying for a new Project, Erasmus +. We have come across several ideas but we still need to put them onto paper.

The Turkish school's proposal is about drugs.

The Italian school's proposal is about agriculture. After some talks going on, we think that the idea would be about sustainable agriculture or farming in different areas, also the production of a product and the distribution of it. We would link this project to biology and entrepreneurship.
