Infant school children:

They do a theatre play of the history of Saint George, and they draw a different picture depending on the year because they can't write yet.

Primary school pupils:

In primary school, the pupils write a story about what they want. This contest is called “La Ploma d’Or”.

If they win, they receive a book which publishes all the winning stories and a rose.



Secondary school and high school students:

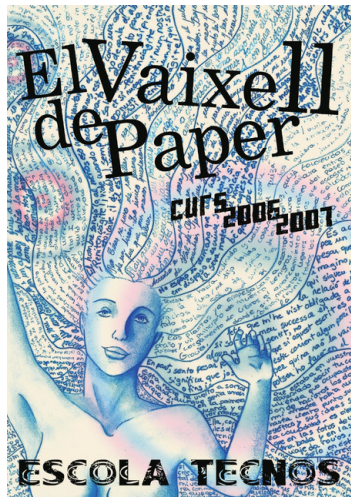
All the students take part in a writing contest, presenting invented stories trying to win the first prize. You can participate in this contest with a story, a poem and an illustration of the writings.

There are different categories, narrative, poetry and drawing, but only two winners for each level.

The winners get a rose, a trophy, a magazine with all the winning writings and money.

The first prize is 80 € and the second prize is 45€. This competition is called “El vaixell de paper”.

On St. Jordi’s day, we go to a concert hall, where all prizes are awarded and a performance of a play is done by a group of students who rehearse during all the school year.
